



2019 ANNUAL REPORT

Littlefeet Environmental (the **Charity**) hereby presents its 2019 annual report and year in review:-

- During the year, the Charity assisted 4 local students in Jersey with the completion of their community volunteer hours to facilitate achieving their bronze and/or silver Duke of Edinburgh (*DofE*) award.
- The Charity was nominated as a finalist for 'Environmentalists of the Year' as part of the Jersey Evening Post's Pride of Jersey Awards and as also one of the chosen charities for the Accuro Jersey Triathlon – the Charity even entered a team of triathletes who finished in 2nd place.
- In continuation of the Charity's annual beach cleaning activities, we partnered with other likeminded organisations in Jersey, such as Ocean Culture Life, Surfers Against Sewage and Plastic Free Jersey, to conduct beach cleans and raise awareness of marine conservation issues facing the island. The Charity was also joined throughout the year by several corporate entities within the island's financial sector, such as the Royal Bank of Canda, Rawlinson & Hunter LLP, Close Finance and Saltgate, who conducted beach cleans with the Charity and enhanced the environmental and social awareness of its employees as part of their CSR initiatives.
- The Charity deployed its first beach cleaning kit at a local café in Jersey, being Kismet Cabana. The beach cleaning kits are accessible to the public all year round.
